

Accelerated Reader Programme

The programme is unique in encouraging reading habits as it assesses a student's reading ability and recommends books appropriate to their level of ability. Very quickly, each student develops a personalised reading list of fiction and non-fiction books which are age and interest appropriate. The highlight of this programme is the ability to guiz on the books read. Once a student has read a book, the programme allows the student to digitally quiz on the book they have read, which provides young readers instant gratification, motivation and information on how well they have understood the book they have read. The more they guiz on books read, greater the opportunity to earn individual merits and house points as a team member. Their efforts will be acknowledged during assembly presentations at the end of each term. As a parent you can personally access the website and see a virtual bookshelf of the books read by your child. We hope that parental encouragement to read and guiz will support the school in its endeavour to promote greater reading habits, which in turn will improve attainment in all subject areas.
